



CAIRNS BASKETBALL INCORPORATED SUMMER LEAGUE COMPETITION 2024/2025 RULES

1. All games will be scheduled in the following manner:
 - Monday Nights – Open Men’s Division 1, Open Women’s Division 1
 - Tuesday Nights – Open Men’s Division 2, Open Women’s Division 2 & Open Mixed
2. Season commences Monday 2nd December and Tuesday 3rd December 2024. This is a 5-week competition with the top two teams going straight into the Grand Final.
3. Teams **must** be registered with Cairns Basketball Inc. (CBI) via the CBI website and Basketball Connect by the nominated team manager and all players must be registered via the invitational link prior to the commencement of the competition. Unregistered players will not be permitted to take the court.
 - Round 1 – Week of 2nd December 2024
 - Round 2 - Week of 9th December 2024
 - Round 3 - Week of 16th December 2024
 - Round 4 - Week of 6th January 2025
 - Round 5 - Week of 13th January 2025
 - Grand Final – Week of 20th January 2025
4. Registration cost is \$110.00 per player, this includes weekly game fees and excludes GST.
5. Teams must have a minimum of six (6) players.
6. To be eligible to participate in the Summer League Competition, players must be 15 years of age and older.
7. Game times will be scheduled for Monday and Tuesday nights 6.30pm, 7.30pm and 8.30pm.
8. All players need to be registered to their team to be eligible to play, no players will be allowed to enter a team casually.
9. Players are permitted to play for only one team in a division.
10. Game times will consist of 10-minute quarters with a three (3) minute half time and one (1) minute quarter time. All game rules will be the same as the Senior Season 2 in 2024.

11. Each team **MUST** have matching coloured playing singlets and have visible numbers (front and back) for the referees and scorers to see. If teams require uniforms, they are available from the CBI office for a cost of \$20 per team (There will also be a \$50.00 cash deposit also which is refunded when the uniforms are returned). Shorts must match singlets or plain black as an alternative. If any player is in incorrect uniform, there will be a 5-point penalty for each item added to the score at the start of the game.
12. During the mixed games, there **must always be at least 2 female players on the court.**
13. During the mixed games, in the first quarter only male players can enter the key on offence and defence. In the second quarter this will swap. Female players though are permitted to enter the key on defence at any time. However, if a player is on a fast break and no one from the opposing team is in the key, any player can enter the key to score. This will be at the discretion of the referee.
14. Players are permitted five (5) fouls only before they are disqualified from the game as per FIBA Rules.
15. Abide by the [Basketball Queensland Codes of Behaviour](#). The Stadium Supervisor/CBI staff have the right to remove any person who does not abide by the rules or Code of Conduct.
16. Respect the referees. Verbal abuse of officials or other players will not be tolerated.
17. Respect the equipment and facilities of CBI.
18. Respect the rights of others and avoid the use of derogatory language based on gender, race, or impairment.
19. Fighting will not be permitted and may result in a suspension from the stadium.
20. Any unsportsmanlike conduct that occurs during game time that is deemed unacceptable by the Stadium Supervisor may result in the game being called off or players disqualified. **Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated.**
21. Summer League 2024/25 is a Social Competition and is for all to enjoy. If any problems occur, please see Stadium Supervisor/CBI staff.
